## **ADJUDICATOR BIOGRAPHY**

Dr William Clark is a Music Educator, Conductor, Adjudicator and Lecturer.

From 1977 – 2011 he was Director of Music at The Scots College, Sydney where he established a thriving Music Department with a large staff and many ensembles including Orchestra, Choir, Chamber Music, Jazz, and a Senior Vocal Ensemble. Many of his students have become professional musicians and many are accomplished musicians who are employed in the major professions. In 1999 the Governor General opened a state-of-the-art Music Centre, and a number of community music groups used the excellent facilities including the Sydney International Piano Competition, The City of Sydney Eisteddfod, and the Music Teachers Association.

William has served as President and Vice-President of the Music Teachers Association, Chairman of the AICM Advisory Board, Chairman of RSCM NSW, President of the Heads of Music Association of Independent Schools in NSW and Conductor of community orchestras and choirs. William was Director of Music at St Thomas' Church North Sydney and is currently the Director of Music at St Mark's Darling Point where he commissioned the Letourneau Pipe Organ which was gifted by the late Nancy Fairfax in 2004.

William holds an Honorary Doctor of Music degree, a Master of Music, BMus, and Graduate Diploma of Music. He has Fellowships by examination and some Honorary Fellowships. These include the Royal School of Church Music UK, the IMEB, the Australian Society of Musicology and Composition, the NMSM UK, the St Cecilia School of Music and the Academy of St Cecilia UK.

William studied singing, organ and piano both in Sydney and the United Kingdom. He also studied improvisation and conducting.

He is active as an Adjudicator and Examiner. Currently he works in schools with HSC Music Students and undertakes work as an internal performance assessor for Elective and Senior music classes. Until recently, William was a member of the AMEB NSW Board and Examinations Committee.



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
